Pyramid of the Magician Uxmal, Mexico

The tallest and most distinctive structure of the Mayan ruins at Uxmal, the Pyramid of the Magician dominates the site. Considered unique because of its rounded sides, height, steep slope, and unusual elliptical base, it gets its name from a legend that it was built by a powerful dwarf magician. The Mayan city of Uxmal flourished from 600-1000 AD. At its height it was home to about 25,000 people.

Joshua Tree National Park California, USA

Sculpted by strong winds, this vast wilderness spanning some 3,000km is made up of two distinct ecosystems. The lower Colorado Desert is 910m below sea level and filled with cacti, scrub and creosote bushes. In the higher, cooler Mojave Desert the iconic Joshua Trees - a gnarled type of Yucca with twisted branches - dominate an ethereal landscape of hills of bare rock, broken up into loose boulders.

Corte Corsica, France

In the centre of the island, in a striking natural setting, circled by jagged peaks at the confluence of several rivers, the dramatic citadel of Corte occupies a towering pinnacle of rock. Below the citadel the main town descends down one street with steep steps leading up to houses and shops. Corte was the capital of the island from 1755-1769 under Pasquale Paoli's short-lived Corsican Republic.

Borobudur Magelang, Java, Indonesia

This famous Buddhist temple, dating from AD 780 to 840, is the world's biggest Buddhist monument, located on a hilltop on the island of Java, amid lush and beautiful scenery. The architecture and stonework make it a marvel of design. Built without any cement or mortar, it consists of nine stacked platforms, topped by a central dome, decorated with 2,672 relief panels and originally 504 Buddha statues.

Lake Tekapo South Island, New Zealand

In the heart of the Mackenzie Region, this remarkable turquoise lake in the dramatic setting of the Southern Alps gets its intense milky-turquoise colour from the fine rock-flour (ground by glaciers), suspended in the water. It is also known for its splendid seasonal display of lupins that bloom along its shores, introduced in the Mackenzie Basin in the 1940s and the slopes of the Roundhill Ski Area.

Fort Borj el Kebir Houmt El Souk, Djerba, Tunisia

Houmt El Souk is the main town of the island of Djerba. A popular tourist destination, it is famous for its traditional souk and the fortress built in the 14th century over the ruins of an ancient Roman city. The rectangular fort is flanked by round and square towers and accessed by a drawbridge. An antiquarium room houses various objects found on site. The walkways offer a superb view of the surroundings and the open sea.

Kyrenia Harbour Cyprus

On the northern coastline of Cyprus, Kyrenia was founded by the Achaeans, ancient Greek colonists, in the 10th century BC and fortified by the Byzantines, Franks, and Venetians. Its picturesque horseshoe-shaped harbour with a backdrop of the jagged mountains behind is flanked by a massive 12th century Crusader castle. Today it is full of yachts and fishing boats with restaurants and cafes around it.

Tombstone Mountain Yukon Territory, Canada

Tombstone Territorial Park's 2,200km² area protects a unique wilderness of rugged peaks, stunning arctic tundra, sparkling lakes, gorgeous alpine meadows and abundant wildlife including black and grizzly bears, caribou, moose, wolves, Dall sheep and marmots. The Dempster Highway passes through the park and provides superb views of the arctic tundra landscapes, wildlife and access to hiking areas.

Otagi Nenbutsu-ji Temple Arashiyama, Kyoto, Japan

This temple, hidden in remote hills has a long and unfortunate history of building, destruction by storms and floods, then rebuilding. It is known for its collection of 1,200 Rakan statues representing Buddha's disciples, many quite humorous, each one unique. They were carved by visitors, guided by priest and sculptor Kocho Nishimura between 1981-91, but they look older as they are covered in moss.

Obertauern Austria

Located in the Salzburg region near to the highest point of the Radstädter Tauern Pass in the Central Eastern Alps at 1,740m, this is one of Austria's biggest and most snow-sure winter sports resorts, renowned for its amazing views and endless kilometres of pistes. In 1920, after the First World War, the first skiers came to Obertauern on foot. Their baggage was transported by horse-drawn sleighs.
